Getting from Oak House to the Schuster and Renold Buildings


If you are staying at Oak House Residence Hall, the best way to travel to the Schuster and Renold Buildings is by using the Manchester city bus system. Buses travel up and down Wilmslow Road / Oxford Road every few minutes all day long. The journey to the Schuster Building takes about 25 minutes; the journey to the Renold Building takes about 30 minutes.

Cost:

A one-way single-trip fare from Oak House to the University area (or back) is £1.00 and can be purchased using cash from the bus driver. However, depending upon how many bus journeys you intend to make during your stay in Manchester, it may be more economical to purchase a weekly pass – this costs £13.50 and can be purchased at the airport, in local shops or from the bus driver.

Directions from Oak house to the SUSY2014 venues:


From Oak House, walk to the bus stop on Wilmslow Road as shown here:



Cross Wilmslow Road so that you are on the north-bound side of the street; the bus stop is near Cawdor Road as shown on the map above.

You can take any of the following buses: 41, 42, 43, 142, 143.

To get to the Schuster Lab (venue of Pre-SUSY2014), stay on the bus approximately 25 minutes; get off in front of the Manchester University Student Union and walk along one of the paths shown here:



To get to the Renold Building (venue of SUSY2014), stay on the bus a little longer, getting off at Hulme Street (just after you have passed under the Mancunian Way elevated highway) and walk along the path shown here (blue dotted line):
